A Parish Plan is a shared vision of how a community sees itself developing over the next few years with an action plan in place for influencing decisions and getting things done.

A Parish Plan is a documented wish list that encompasses the views of the whole of the community, whatever their age, based upon input from all residents, group members, facility users and businesses in the Parish.

To produce the plan we aim to involve as many people as possible and we need your help and support to make it happen.

Plans in other parts of the country have been used to help secure grants, influence planning decisions and to provide the justification for better local services.
